## WHAT: INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS

**DESCRIPTION:** Based on the framework of ABC+P (attendance, behavior, coursework, and parental involvement), Project: MENTOR activities can be intensive for one student, targeted to achieve an overall result in a group of students, or universally available to the entire school—depending on the needs of the school and the level of Communities In Schools involvement.

Activities could include:

- One-on-one mentoring/tutoring
- Group mentoring activities (Boys Club, Girls Club, SMARTS martial arts,
- Remediation
- Student assistance (BackPack Pals, school supplies, field trip assistance, holiday food, emergency needs, clothing assistance, and Sight for Students glasses vouchers)
- Healthy living (Cooking Matters, GOFAR, health/safety fairs)
- New Century Scholars (scholarship awarded at the end of sixth grade to attend Randolph County Community College for two years)
- Service learning (peer mentor Buddies)
- Guest speakers
- Attendance incentives
- Book distributions
